I. President's FY 2022 Budget is Released

- **CEF's funding table and analysis will be sent in a separate CEF Update later today.**
- **Links for President's Budget** – The Office of Management and Budget (OMB) has posted [the President's fiscal year \(FY\) 2022 budget materials online](#); the discretionary topline budget was released in early April. Today's materials include:
 - **"Budget" document** – it usually has a chapter for each agency, but this year is organized thematically instead. Education initiatives are discussed throughout, including in the Build Back Better section and the Expanding Opportunity section. At the end are the summary tables that show the cost impact of mandatory spending and tax proposals on Table S.6.
 - **Budget Appendix** (detailed funding data that can be hard to follow)
 - **Historical Tables** (not yet posted, but I love these tables! Very helpful for doing big-picture analysis of funding trends)
 - **Analytical Perspectives** (economic and accounting analysis, it often has a section explaining the complicated financing of the Pell Grant program)
- **ED's budget materials** - The Department of Education (ED) has post its customary [budget materials here](#), including the Congressional Justifications that detail programmatic and funding data for each program, and the summary document that has a handy funding table at the end.
- **Other education-related budget materials** – Other agencies are also likely to post their own materials shortly. Some education-related budgets already posted include:
