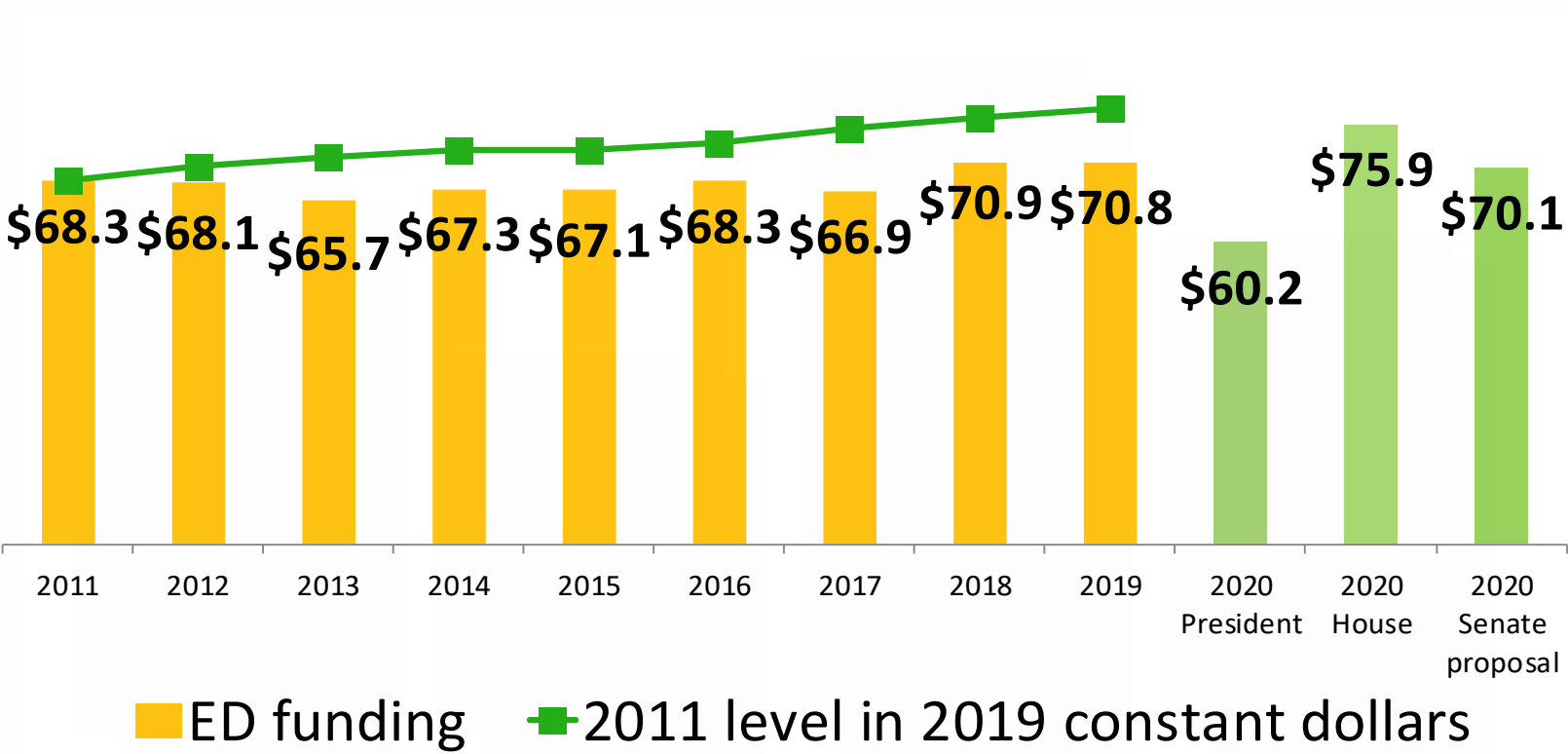


Education Investment is \$7 Billion Below 2011 Level in Inflation-Adjusted Terms

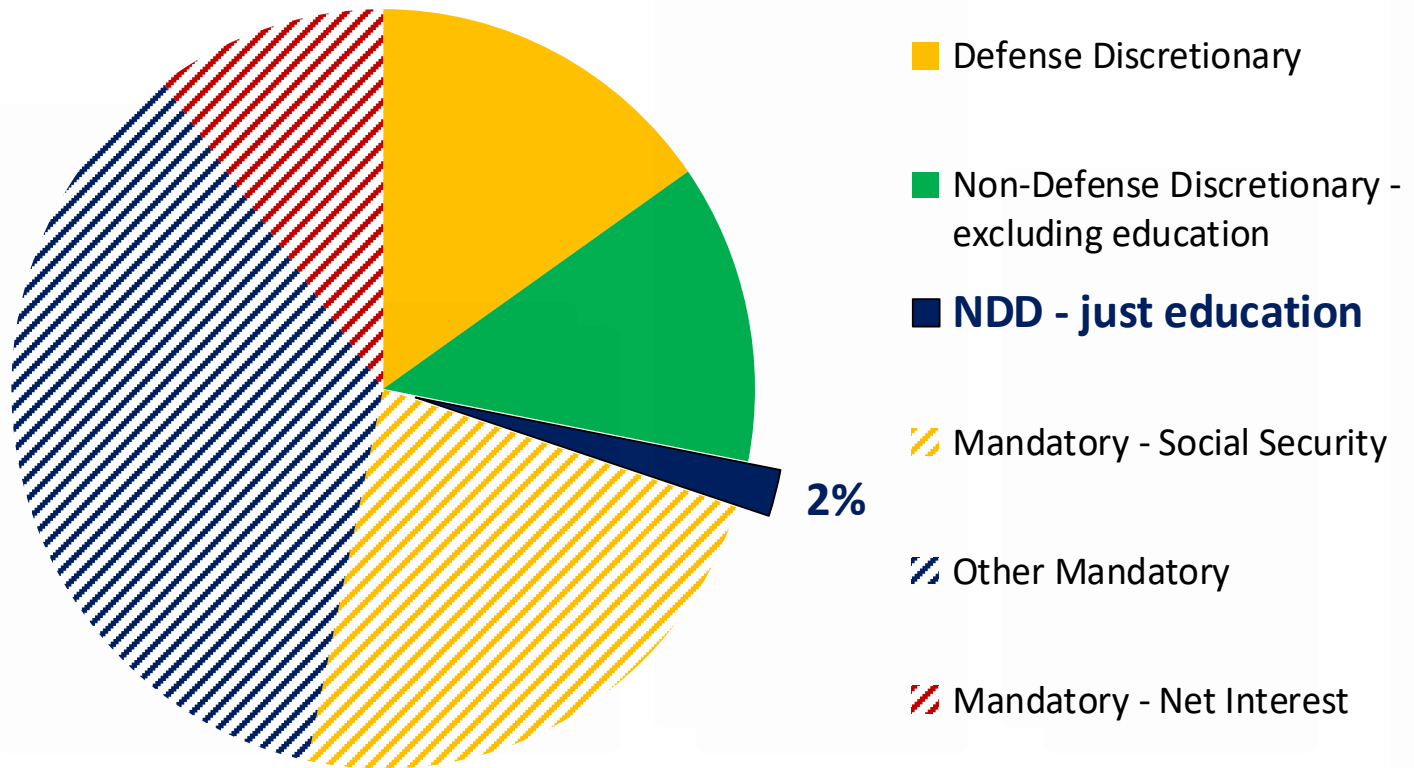

Education Accounts for Less Than 2% of All Federal Spending

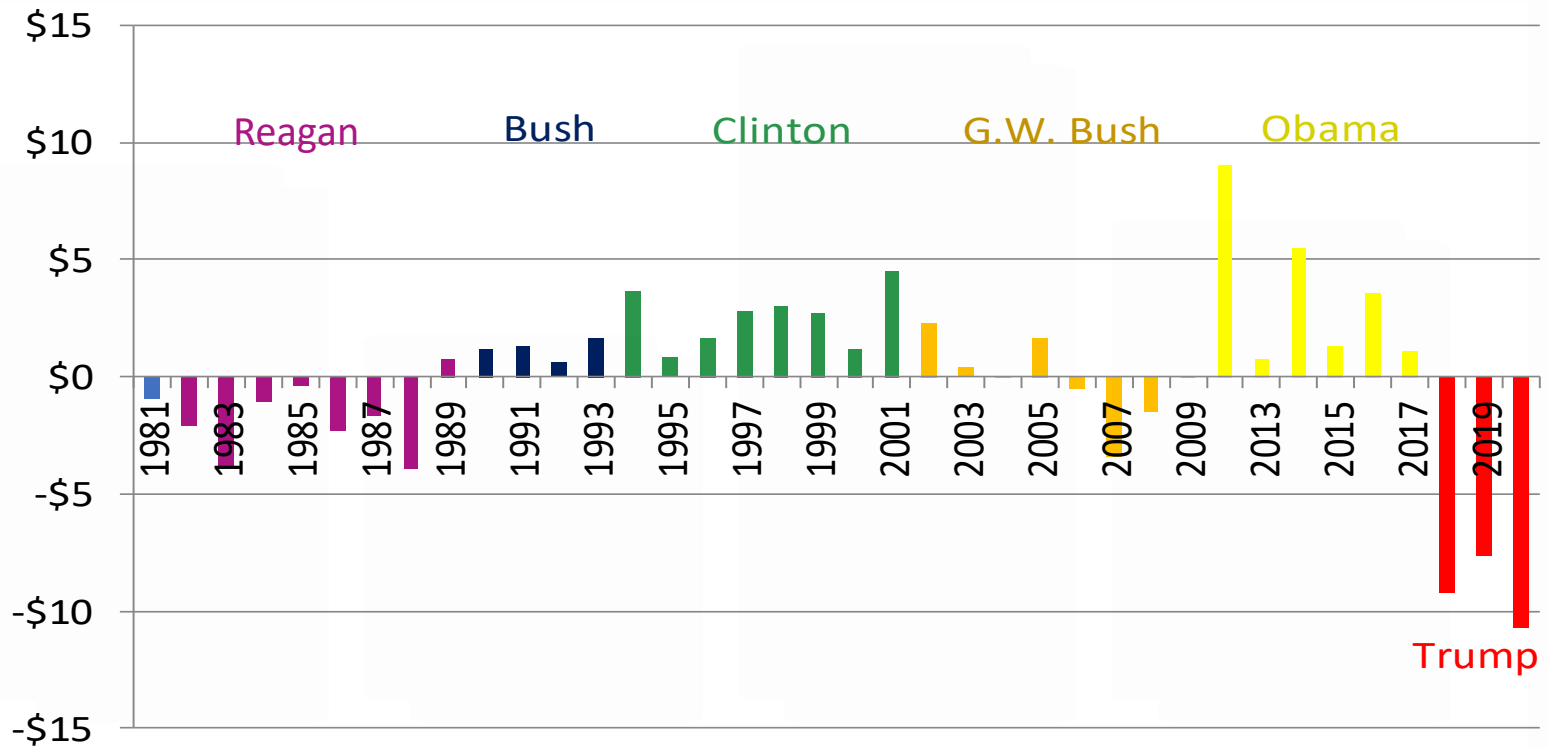
2020 President's Budget Outlays by Category
